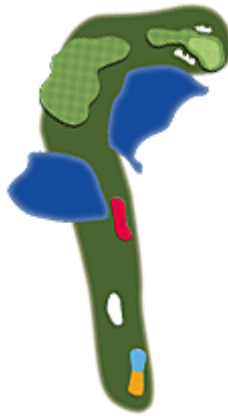


A mid to long iron shot is required to this straight away par 3. The green is long so be aware of pin placement.

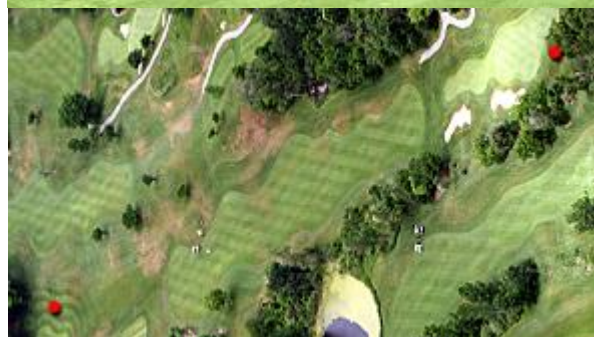
